

Covington Puppy Park

Rules

Park Hours:

7am-7pm

Closed on Mondays from 7am-2pm for maintenance

Closed 2nd Thursday of the Month for Flea Control

Enter at your own risk. The City of Covington is not liable for the actions or inactions of dogs or their owners.

- Owner must be within visual sight and voice control of their dog at all times. No dog should be left unattended.
- Dog owners **MUST** clean up after their pet and fill all holes their dog digs or they will be banned from entering the dog park.
- All dogs must have current vaccinations (distemper, hepatitis, kennel cough and rabies).
- Person with dog must be 17 years old or older.
- No dog or human food, glass containers or alcohol allowed inside the park area.
- No smoking.
- No aggressive dogs allowed. If aggressive behavior occurs, the dog must leave the park.
- Puppies under 4 months are prohibited.
- Dog owners must have a leash with them at **ALL** times.
- Dogs in season are **NOT** allowed.
- No infants or small children under 12 allowed in Dog Park.
- Spayed/neutered animals recommended.

- Dog owners are limited to 1 dog per visit.
- Dog owners are completely responsible for their dog's actions.
- Dogs **MUST** be leashed entering and **BEFORE** leaving the park area.
- Dogs left unattended will be impounded.
- No strollers, bicycles, skateboards, or roller blades are allowed in the dog park. Wheelchairs are allowed.
- Professional dog trainers are not allowed to use this park to conduct business.
- No running, jumping and/or petting someone's dog without permission.
- No grooming or bathing dog in the park.
