



Coastal Environmental Services is responsible for the City of Covington's collection, transportation, and disposal of residential and commercial solid waste, including green waste, and recyclable materials from residential units.

If you are new to the area, need a garbage or recycling cart, or have a question and/or concern, please call Coastal Environmental Services at 985-781-3171. We are here to help and ensure your waste is collected in a professional and timely manner. Coastal Environmental Services will provide one (1) 96-gallon cart for solid waste and one (1) 64-gallon cart for recyclables at no charge. **Please have cart curbside by 6am on day of collection.** Please contact the City of Covington to inquire about additional carts.

Coastal Environmental Services provides curbside collection of residential and commercial solid waste once per week. We also provide collection of recyclable materials once per week. **Your recycling day is now every Thursday.** Please see list below of items that the processing company will accept for recycling. Recycle weight is restricted to 75 lbs. per cart.

Bulky Waste - Available curbside once per week. Bulky waste must be placed curbside prior to collection. Material cannot exceed 6 feet in length. The pile should have a 3-foot clearance from stationary objects and should NOT be placed under power lines. Whenever possible, please bag or place your green waste in the cart.

Curbside - Place carts adjacent to paved or traveled city roads (including alleys) where mail service is provided. Carts, recycle carts, green waste, and bulky waste shall be placed as close to the roadway as practicable without interfering with or endangering the movement of vehicles or pedestrians. **Please do not place carts or material within 3 feet of your mailbox.**

Hours of Operation - Collection of solid waste from residential units shall not start before 6:00 am.

Holidays - Coastal Environmental Services only observes three (3) holidays: Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day. Please visit the CES website at www.ces-la.com or the City's website for makeup days. Please contact CES (985-781-3171) if you have any questions.

Complaints - All complaints shall be made directly to Coastal Environmental Services and will be given prompt and courteous attention. Should a missed collection occur, please call 985-781-3171 and a recovery will occur within 24 hours of the call.

ORANGE CONTAMINATED TAPE - If a piece of Orange tape is placed on your recycling cart, this means you had items that are not recyclable and therefore your recyclables will have to be dumped on your next Garbage Day.

What can be recycled?

Coastal Environmental Services accepts the following recyclable materials:

- **Cardboard**
- **Paper**
 - Mixed Office Paper
 - Magazines/Catalogs
 - Newspapers
 - Shredded Paper
(must be loose or in clear bag)
- **Aluminum Food & Beverage Containers**
- **Plastics - Numbered 1, 2 ONLY**
 - Soft Drinks
 - Mineral Water
 - Fruit Juice
 - Cooking Oil
 - Milk Jugs
 - Cleaning Agents
 - Laundry Detergent
 - Bleaching agents
 - Shampoo Bottles
 - Washing Soap

What items are not recyclable?

Coastal Environmental Services does not accept the following recyclable materials:

- **Plastics - Numbered 3-7:**
 - PVC - pipes
 - LDPE - ziplocs & grocery bags
 - PP - diapers & margarine containers
 - PS - spoons, coffee cups
 - PC - baby bottles, CDs
- **Metals** - Ferrous metals, large sheets of tin or aluminum
- **Organic Waste**
- **Glass is not accepted**
- **Plastic Bags are not accepted**
