**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2020-22**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON  
DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY OWNED BY THE  
CITY OF COVINGTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION  
WITH THE DONATION OF SAID SURPLUS PROPERTY  
TO THE WASHINGTON PARISH FIRE DISTRICT NO. 5**

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the property described below is no longer needed for the public purposes of the Fire Department for the City of Covington:

- 1 Mako AC 05 Air Charge Compressor,
- 1 Mako Compair Fill Station, and 2 Air Cylinders 4500 PSI

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City Council for the City of Covington to comply with Louisiana state law regarding the disposition of surplus property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council for the City of Covington, Louisiana, in regular session convened, that the movable property described above is hereby declared not needed for public use and therefore surplus; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that said surplus property described above shall be disposed of pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statute 38:2319.21 and the Mayor is hereby authorized to donate such surplus movable property to the Washington Parish Fire District No. 5 and to execute any and all documents in connection with said donation; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that if any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
