ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-17

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON
SETTING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR
OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON FOR THE YEAR 2022**

WHEREAS, the Covington Home Rule Charter, Section 3-08, provides that the compensation for the Mayor for the City of Covington for the year ending December 31, 2022, be established at the time of the adoption of the 2022 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Covington has adopted the Operating Budget for the City of Covington for the year ending December 31, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Covington, in regular session convened, that the compensation of the Mayor of the City of Covington under the Home Rule Charter for the year ending December 31, 2022, shall be set as follows:

- 1) Annual salary of 90,669.28 representing the same rate of compensation as the Year 2021:
- 2) City-sponsored health insurance with the same contribution to employee and dependent premiums as is afforded other full-time City employees;
- 3) Life insurance with a \$50,000 benefit, the premium being paid by the City, as is done for other full-time employees;
- 4) Long-term disability insurance, the premium being paid by the City, as is done for other full-time City employees;
- 5) Benefit provisions of the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (FICA) to be collected as payroll taxes/contributions to the social insurance system (Social Security) in lieu of retirement benefits; the Mayor does not participate in the Municipal Employees Retirement System (MERS) as other eligible municipal employees;
- 6) Worker's compensation insurance, the premium being paid by the City;
- 7) Medicare, with the same contribution by the City as is afforded other full-time City employees and as is required by law;
- 8) In lieu of a City-owned vehicle for city and personal use, a vehicle allowance of seven hundred fifty (\$750.00) dollars per month for the

- 1 use of a personal vehicle, which allowance is considered part of total
- 2 compensation by the IRS and will be taxed accordingly;
- 3 9) Annual allowance of six hundred (\$600.00) dollars representing a
- 4 stipend for partial reimbursement for public use of a currently private
- 5 cellular telephone; and
- 6 10) City-issued smart phone or small tablet to be used as a laptop for
- 7 answering City emails.

9 **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that if any provision of this ordinance
10 shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein
11 which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the
12 provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

13 **WHEREUPON**, this ordinance having been submitted in writing, having
14 been read by title and adopted at a public meeting of the City Council of the City
15 of Covington, State of Louisiana, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole,
16 the vote thereon being as follows:
