- a. Demolish existing Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) roadway from Karen Drive to Kathleen Drive and associated concrete curb, sidewalks, and driveways.
- b. Install new roadside subsurface drainage system along Lurline Drive from Karen Drive to Kathleen Drive.
- c. Restore disrupted utility connections where applicable.
- d. Reconstruct Lurline Drive from Karen Drive to Kathleen Drive using PCC roadway type construction.
- e. Restore sidewalks and driveways as necessary.

**6. Review of Plans and Specifications and Questions:**

- a. No questions will be accepted after COB on Thursday, June 16, 2022. HDCA offices close at 5:30 PM and is hence designated as the COB time.
- b. The CONTRACTOR's working hours shall be limited to ordinary working hours of 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM, Monday through Friday. The CONTRACTOR may work outside of normal hours with the permission of the OWNER and ENGINEER. Such requests shall be tendered to the ENGINEER a minimum of 48 hours prior to the proposed work outside of normal working hours. Night WORK will generally not be allowed. The CONTRACTOR is alerted to the Construction and Schedule Constraints specified within these Special Provisions.
- c. Modifications to existing facilities, the construction of new facilities, and the connection of new to existing facilities may require the temporary closure of existing roadways and driveways. The closure request shall be submitted to the ENGINEER a minimum of two (2) weeks in advance of the time that such closure is required. The closure plan shall be coordinated with the construction schedule and shall meet the restrictions and conditions of these Special Provisions. The closure request shall describe the CONTRACTOR's temporary traffic control plan, the length of time to complete the operation, and the manpower, plant, and equipment to ensure that WORK requiring the closure is completed within the scheduled time for the closure. All costs for preparing and implementing the closure plan shall be the responsibility of the CONTRACTOR as part of the WORK. The CONTRACTOR shall not enact a roadway, driveway, or sidewalk closure until written approval has been granted by the ENGINEER in each case.
- d. The CONTRACTOR shall conduct a Pre-construction Site Survey, Post-construction Site Survey, and vibration monitoring during construction. The CONTRACTOR shall conduct the surveys in accordance with the

limits and features shown in the Site Conditions Survey Requirements Plan. The CONTRACTOR shall perform Pre-construction Site Survey prior the initiation of any construction activities which may reasonably be expected to create vibrations. The CONTRACTOR shall provide vibration monitoring during all activities that may cause vibrations.

- e. The CONTRACTOR shall conduct sampling and testing in accordance with the requirements of the Contract Documents. The list below comprises the minimum sampling and testing anticipated to be required for the CONTRACTOR to the ENGINEER in accordance with Section 01010. Additional testing may be required by the ENGINEER at his discretion. If additional samples are required, provide them at no additional cost to the OWNER.
  - i. River Sand for Backfill
  - ii. Bedding and Haunching Material
  - iii. Geotextile Fabric (material will not be tested unless questionable)
  - iv. Portland cement concrete mixtures
  
- f. The CONTRACTOR shall video at a minimum the following areas for site conditions:
  - i. All areas to be entered by vehicles or equipment, including construction areas for both internal and executed improvements.
  - ii. Areas requiring manhole work.
  - iii. Paved and unpaved areas which will be entered by vehicles or equipment.
  - iv. Areas surrounding construction operations including exterior/interior of homes within a 200' radius of construction.
  
- g. The CONTRACTOR shall adhere to the requirements of Section 02713 – Temporary Traffic Controls. The list below does not include all requirements.
  - i. When signs to be furnished and erected by the CONTRACTOR are in place, ensure the CONTRACTOR's Traffic Control Supervisor (TCS) covers any standard signs that are in conflict with the temporary signs.
  - ii. Use qualified flaggers. Assume full and sole responsibility for training or assuring that all flaggers are qualified to perform flagging duties.
  - iii. Assume responsibility for the inspection of all traffic control devices every calendar day that traffic control devices are in use. This inspection may be delegated to the TCT. The "Quality Guidelines for Work Zone Traffic Control Devices" must be used to evaluate the condition of the traffic control devices to determine if acceptable for use. Provide for the immediate repair, cleaning, or replacement of any traffic control devices not functioning as required to ensure

the safety of motorists, pedestrians, and construction personnel and/or not meeting the ATSSA standard. Conduct inspection of traffic control devices by the TCS at the beginning and end of each workday, and as directed by the ENGINEER during the workday. Inspect the traffic control devices on weekends, holidays, or other non – work days at least once per day. Inspect traffic control devices at least once per week during nighttime periods and the same night after any modifications or changes have been made in the traffic control devices.

h. The CONTRACTOR shall provide concrete manholes which include the following protective admixtures:

- Provide concrete waterproofing system of the crystalline type that chemically controls and permanently fixes a non-soluble crystalline structure throughout the capillary voids of the concrete. Ensure the system causes the concrete to become sealed against the penetration of liquids from any direction, and protects the concrete from deterioration due to harsh environmental conditions. Furnish crystalline waterproofing additive which includes an approved coloring that will tint the finished concrete as proof of additive. Coloring must be provided by the additive manufacturer. Require the manufacturer or manufacturer's representative to approved of the installer of crystalline waterproofing additive in writing. Add crystalline waterproofing additive to concrete mix at time of batching, and conduct dosage rates and installation in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations. Provide crystalline waterproofing additive manufactured by Xypex Chemical Corporation or approved equal.
  - Utilize antimicrobial additive to provide long term prevention of bacterial corrosion if concrete in Microbial Induced Corrosive (MIC) sanitary sewer environments. Ensure it renders the concrete uninhabitable for bacteria growth. Provide an EPA registered material for liquid antibacterial additive. The product must include an approved coloring that will tint the finished concrete as proof of additive. Coloring must be provided by the additive manufacturer. Ensure the installer of anti-microbial additive is certified by the manufacturer or manufacturer's representative in writing. Add the additive to the concrete mix water to ensure even distribution throughout the concrete mixture. Use the amounts as recommended by the manufacturer of the antibacterial additive. Include the amount in the total water content of the concrete mix design. Ensure the anti-microbial additive has successfully demonstrated prevention of MIC in sanitary sewers for ten or more years. Furnish anti-microbial additive as manufactured by Conshield Technologies or approved equal.
- i. The CONTRACTOR shall not advance pipe laying backfilling by more than 100 feet without approval by the ENGINEER.
